#### Asset Protection Zone (APZ)

An area between a bush fire hazard and buildings or other assets that is kept clear of bushfire fuels and obstructions to firefighting.



#### Strategic Fire Advantage Zone (SFAZ)

An area in which bush fire fuels that most affect fire spread and intensity are deliberately reduced through methods such as prescribed burning or livestock grazing.



#### **Residential Preparation Area**

An area in which residents prepare their property for fire as shown in the illustration above.

#### Fire Trail

A road specifically built and maintained for the purpose of accessing a property or area for fire management.



#### Neighbourhood Safer Place

A place of last resort during a bush fire emergency. . www.rfs.nsw.gov.au/nsp
