



# MyRFS UPDATE

NEW FEATURES AND IMPROVEMENTS

November 2014



The MyRFS team are pleased to announce that we have released a number of new features and bug fixes to MyRFS based on feedback from MyRFS users. These updates are outlined below:

## Callout stats update

A bug was fixed in the brigade callouts, individual callouts and member callouts modules to allow MyRFS to properly display incidents that have been entered into BIRS. This fix is retrospective, so users should be able to see all incidents they have entered since the BIRS system went live, as well as all old FIRS reports. In addition, reports should now be visible in MyRFS as soon as they are submitted.

## Group Captains callout stats upgrade

This is a new feature that has been frequently requested by Group Captains. It allows Group Captains and Deputy Group Captains to be able to see callout data for all brigades in any LGA where they are recorded as a Group Captain. To select a brigade to display callout information for, a drop down menu has

been added listing all available brigades. This feature is available in the callout stats module by going to My Brigade>Callout Stats menu within MyRFS.

## COP enhancements

There have been some minor changes to the way the COP appears and a number of usability enhancements, including the reintroduction of the lightning layer for volunteer members.

## Fire Weather

An exciting new feature that allows members to be able to view a range of detailed weather information and predictions for any area in the state. It is available by going to Resources>Fire Weather menu within MyRFS. Further information about this tool is available in the November [Operational Brief](#).
