FIRE TRAILS SYMBOLOGY

What are the Fire Trails Symbols for?

The RFS, in consultation with NSW land management agencies have developed a suite of standardised symbology representing the various fire trail attributes used in FAFT plans and other operational systems. The intended use for the fire trail mapping symbology is for the 'Identified Fire Trails' as these are the trails that will be mapped for operational purposes i.e. in CAD and MDTs.

Engineered crossing	Trail signage	Tactical Fire Trail, Category 1 Appliance
Bed level crossing	Fixed water point	Tactical Fire Trail, Category 7 Appliance
Piped culvert	Tree down	Tactical Fire Trail, Category 9 Appliance
Engineered culverts and bridges		Track / Other, Category 1 Appliance
Operational support points		Track / Other, Category 7 Appliance
