

## What are the Fire Trails Symbols for?

The RFS, in consultation with NSW land management agencies have developed a suite of standardised symbology representing the various fire trail attributes used in FAFT plans and other operational systems. The intended use for the fire trail mapping symbology is for the 'Identified Fire Trails' as these are the trails that will be mapped for operational purposes i.e. in CAD and MDTs.
